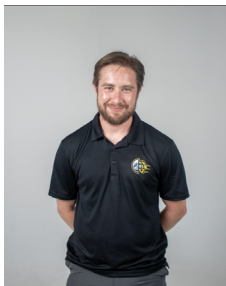

Veteran coach Bob Koopmann brings nearly three decades of collegiate coaching experience, including 20 successful seasons at Rockford University, to the Rivets organization. Known for building competitive, winning programs, Koopmann led the Regents to three conference titles and two tournament championships, highlighted by a school-record 29-win season in 2007. Throughout his tenure, he has also helped develop multiple players into professional baseball, showcasing his ability to elevate talent to the next level.

Just prior to his arrival at Rockford, Koopmann was the head coach for 2 seasons (05-06) at Ashford University in Clinton, Iowa. In Koopmann's second season with the Saints they won a school record 23 games. Prior to coaching at Ashford, Koopmann spent the first 7 years (98-04) of his head coaching career at Illinois Valley Community College in Oglesby, Ill. In 1999 Koopmann turned the program around by improving the Eagles from just 5 wins to a then record 27 wins. His teams won the Regional Championships from 2001 through 2003. In his 7 years at IVCC the Eagles were 241-171 (.585 winning percentage).

He served as the manager for the Rockford RiverHawks from 2002 through 2004 and again from 2008 through 2010. His teams compiled a 297-270 record (.524 winning percentage) over that time frame including a Frontier League Championship in 2004 where the RiverHawks finished 65-39 including the postseason.

The Chicago native played his college baseball at Harper College in Palatine, Ill. While at Harper he was drafted twice by the Chicago White Sox organization. Koopmann later signed with the Pittsburgh Pirates where he pitched in their minor league system for three seasons. He resides in Rockford with his wife, Laura, and their two children, Frank and Lyla.

Jake Bilotta | Assistant Coach | 1st Season



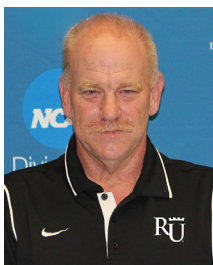

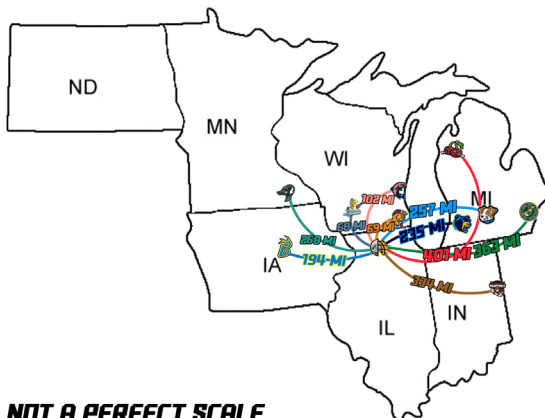

Piechocki's has been the Growlers manager since 2015 and in the Northwoods League since 2013.

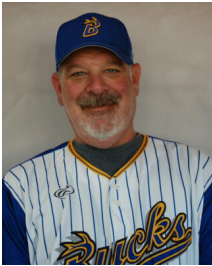

After leading the franchise to a 42-30 record in 2025, the Waterloo Bucks announced on March 31 that field manager Darrell Handelsman would be returning to the team in 2026. Handelsman currently serves as the head coach at Olney Central Community College, a position he has held for two spring seasons. This will be Handelsman's eighth season in Waterloo.

In 2025, the Bucks finished with the second-best overall record in the Great Plains East Division of the Northwoods League. The sixth game of the season marked Handelsman's 500th victory for his NWL career and on June 17, he notched his 500th career regular season win. Handelsman is the winningest manager in team history, with 276 victories, and ranks as the third-winningest manager in NWL history, with 525 victories. A veteran manager in summer-collegiate baseball, Handelsman holds 871 career wins with six different teams in a career spanning 20-plus seasons. Prior stops include the Kenosha Kroakers (Northwoods League, 1997-98), Waterloo Bucks (NWL, 1999-2002), Madison Mallards (NWL, 2003-04), Fayetteville Swampdogs (Coastal Plain League, 2005-13), Green Bay Bullfrogs (NWL, 2013-16), and Alton River Dragons (Prospect League, 2021-22). Handelsman is the second winningest postseason manager in league history with 12 victories. In addition, Handelsman has won two NWL titles, earning trophies with the Bucks in 2002 and Madison in 2004.

Handelsman's coaching career began as an assistant at Los Angeles Valley College, followed by New Mexico Highlands University, Cochise College, San Jose State University, and Centenary College. Handelsman played collegiately at San Francisco State University.

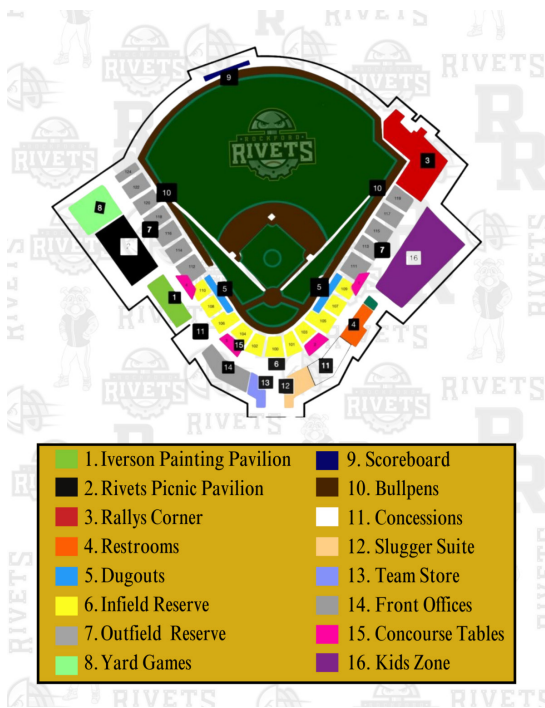

Rivets Stadium opened in 2006 where it was originally the host to the Rockford Riverhawks of the Frontier League. The Rivets took over the stadium in the fall of 2015 after the demise of the Rockford Aviators. Rivets Stadium has also been home to the Rockford University Regents baseball team since 2007. The stadium has 3,279 seats, but can host crowds of over 4,000.
