CAREER NOTES

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN: Threw a season-high 7.1 innings with nine strikeouts on April 1, 2022 against North Carolina A&T... Made first career start on February 26, 2022 against Delaware State... Spent majority of the 2022 season as the Friday starter for the Buccaneers... Tabbed as the 18th best 2022 MLB Draft prospect out of the Big South by D1Baseball...

CROWDER: Started 13 games as a sophomore, finished top-10 nationally in wins (10) and complete games (5)... Struck out a career-high 11 twice against Colby (March 6, 2021) and Three Rivers (March 27, 2021)... 83 strikeouts and 3.03 ERA were both top-50 nationally in 2021... Won final nine decisions to end 2021 after dropping third start of the year



a freshman in 2020... Ranked as the 400th-best prospect in the 2020 MLB Draft by Baseball America...

DANVILLE (PL): Made eight appearances and six starts for the Dans in the Prospect League... Set careerhigh with 11 strikeouts on August 2, 2019 against Lafayette... Allowed three earned runs or less in all eight appearances.

OLE MISS: Spent the year in the bulloen for the Rebels, made 14 appearances... Threw a third of an inning in the NCAA Tournament at #4 Arkansas in game one of the Fayetteville Super Regional... Threw a perfect two-thirds of an inning against Georgia in the SEC Tournament semifinals.

PREP: Drafted in the 39th Round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Cleveland Indians... Top ranked lefthanded pitcher, second-best overall prospect out of Arkansas, nationally ranked as the 26th-best left-handed pitcher by *Perfect Game* in the Class of 2018... Ranked as the 205th-best prospect in the 2018 MLB Draft by *Baseball America...*Three-time *Perfect Game* Preseason All-American selection from 2016-18... All-State selection each of his final three years... Tallied a career 0.92 ERA in four years with 184 strikeouts... Spent time as a receiver for the football team and a forward with basketball.
