Position Overview:

As a Pitch Clock Operator, you'll manage the ballpark's pace-of-play clock during Duluth Huskies home games in accordance with Northwoods League guidelines. This role requires strong attention to detail, focus throughout the game, and a general understanding of baseball. It's a great opportunity for fans who want a unique behind-the-scenes role during live games.

Responsibilities:

- Operate the ballpark's pitch clock system during Duluth Huskies home games.
- Manage the 20-second action clock between pitches in accordance with league pace-of-play rules.
- Operate additional timers, including mound visit clocks, pitching change timers, and between-inning clocks.
- Reset and monitor clocks throughout the game while paying close attention to the flow of play.
- Work with the umpires and Duluth Huskies staff to ensure proper clock management.
- Arrive prior to first pitch for setup and meeting with umpires and remain through the conclusion of the game.

Requirements:

- Strong attention to detail and ability to remain focused during live gameplay.
- Basic understanding of baseball rules and game flow.
- Reliable, punctual, and able to work evenings, weekends, and holidays.
- Reliable transportation to and from Wade Stadium.
- Availability to work the majority of the 36 home games throughout the summer.
