This role is perfect for high school students looking for a first job with real responsibility in a fast-paced sports environment.

Responsibilities:

- Sell tickets and handle cash transactions at your assigned window.
- Run your own ticket window independently for the majority of the gameday (~3.5–4 hours per game).
- Greet fans, answer questions, and provide friendly, professional service.
- Support walk-up ticket sales, will-call, and player pass pickup if needed.
- Communicate with gameday staff and manager to manage lines or special situations.
- Follow all ballpark policies and safety procedures.

Requirements:

- Reliable, punctual, and able to work evenings, weekends, and select holidays.
- Friendly, professional, and able to work independently.
- Basic computer skills are helpful; full training is provided.
- Reliable transportation to and from Wade Stadium.
- Availability to work the majority of our 36 home games throughout the summer (*we understand occasional conflicts, but consistent attendance is required*).
