



Welcome to the Pit Spitters 2026 Reading Program! As a 2026 Pit Spitters Reading Program participant, we look forward to working with you to encourage literacy and hard work in our community and have fun doing it! Below is the general outline about how the program works. Whether you are a first-time participant, or have joined the reading club in previous years, we're glad you're here!

How the program works: The Pit Spitters reading program is based on students' success and hard work in the classroom, in exchange for **ONE FREE** Pit Spitters ticket voucher! This year, the Pit Spitters will mail one ticket voucher for every participating student to the teacher or administrator of the program **AHEAD** of the start of the program. The teacher or administrator is responsible for letting the Pit Spitters know how many students plan on participating in the program by filling out the attached form. As an example, if a teacher says 15 students in their classroom will participate in the program, they will receive 15 ticket vouchers from the Pit Spitters ahead of March 1, 2026. As each student completes the required benchmarks as determined by the teacher, they will receive **ONE FREE** ticket.

The students who receive ticket vouchers can redeem them **ONLINE**, in-person at the box office the day of their desired game, or over the phone. All additional tickets can be purchased for family and friends with each option. The additional tickets will be offered at the exclusive rate of \$10 for the program. Tickets purchased online are subject to a Northwoods League processing fee per ticket, including the free tickets. Our intention in increasing redemption options is to eliminate the need for mail in forms, and to make it easier for students and their families to use their ticket vouchers.

Reading Tracking Calendars are back by popular demand and will be sent to you via email at your request along with the other required documentation to get started.

The Pit Spitters Reading Program kicks off March 2026 and continues throughout the entire month of March. Teachers, if you'd like to start earlier or later, feel free to distribute the earned tickets to students as you see fit.

If your school is planning a class field trip on either our School Day Game on June 4th at 11:05 a.m. or any of our other days, we will send one **FREE** ticket for each student, teacher, chaperone, and bus driver for the selected game. Additional tickets for family members for the field trip can be purchased together so everyone can sit together during the game.

Teachers and administrators facilitating on behalf of their classrooms, please remember to indicate the total number of students participating in the program. The Pit Spitters will then send back **ONE FREE** ticket voucher for each student. The ticket vouchers will include a redemption code that is used when redeemed using any of the methods above. You will receive a supplemental document with instructions for redemption at a later date.
