JOB DESCRIPTION

Internship positions will work long hours on Bucks game days along with other events at Riverfront Stadium. Should expect to work ALL Bucks home games, various ticket office shifts, and during extra events at Riverfront Stadium. Interns will also assist in guerilla marketing efforts throughout the Cedar Valley during the season.

- Start Date: May 13, 2024
- End Date: August 17, 2024
- This position works closely with the Bucks head groundskeeper
- Assist with oversight and maintenance of the Riverfront Stadium playing field
 - Including dragging field, painting and chalking lines, plate and mound repair, mowing, etc.
- Maintain all grassy areas in and around the ballpark, including mowing, weed eating, leaf blowing, etc.
- Set up and maintain Bucky's Backyard Ballpark
- Assist with setup and tear down of batting practice for Bucks home games
- Serve as the groundskeeper for all extra events held at Riverfront Stadium (high school tournaments, little league games, etc.)
- Assist with other stadium operations duties leading up to Bucks home games
- Assist with game operations, box office, on-field games, souvenir stand, and guest services
- Provide outstanding customer service to advertisers and fans
- Be trained on the ticket system and fulfill ticket office duties
- Other duties as assigned
